### What we can offer:

As a young person in business (31 and under) we would like to give you the opportunity to showcase your business and sell your products/services to 40,000 people over 2 full days.

The Traders Village will offer a large 6ft table and 7ft space per Business and will be inside a large Marquee. Please note chairs are not provided. This space is at a cost of £100 for the weekend and power will be provided. The space must be manned on both days between 12 noon and 10.30pm/9.30pm (Sunday), we are unable to accept applications for 1 day only.

### Terms & Conditions

#### The event

- The event is open to the public between 12 noon to 10:30pm on Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> June and 12 noon to 9.30pm on Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> July 2018.
- Stalls must only offer what is specified in their application. Any changes to the application form must be made in writing to the Event Officer at least four weeks prior to the event.
- Sub-Contracting: Stalls and spaces or parts of stalls or spaces by traders is **not** permitted.
- Stall holders must arrive on Friday 29<sup>th</sup> June 2018 by 7pm to set up their stall
- The Management reserve the right to reallocate stalls if essential for operational reasons or if stallholders arrive late.
- Amplified music: No Music to be played without prior agreement with the event management.
- Strictly no selling/collection of donations are allowed.

- Strictly no food or drink to be given away for free or sold
- Traders must be aware of the needs of people with disabilities: For example “how would you serve a person who in a wheelchair?”

## **Parking**

Please note that there is limited trader parking close to the site. This will be strictly limited to one vehicle per trader, and will only be accessible with the correct vehicle pass. There will be vehicle access for unloading & loading during the times stated. We would ask that transport is removed from the access area as soon as you have unloaded to prevent congestion and allow other suppliers to unload/load. The trader car parking will be located south side of the field (opposite the event) – access will be permitted with a traders pass issued in your Traders Pack once your booking is confirmed.

## **Food**

Cash catering will be available at our food village throughout the day should you wish to purchase food or drinks.

## **Health & Safety**

- Traders must comply with the Health, Safety and Hygiene requirement of the Event Management and Dumfries and Galloway Council.
- Traders are not permitted to start trading until they have been given the go ahead by the Health and Safety Officer, following a Health and Safety Inspection.
- Official organisation: Traders are required to co-operate fully with Event and Site Management, The Event Safety Officer, Security, Emergency Services, Police and all official Officers, Fire Officers, Customs and Excise staff, SEPA, Trading Standards Officers and Inland Revenue staff.

- Wastewater Disposal: Traders are responsible for making own arrangement and disposing waste water on the ground
- Promotional give-aways: Strictly no items that can be used as missiles allowed on site, i.e. freebies, stress balls, glow sticks etc. If you require guidance on what can be used please contact the Event Office
- An Emergency access route will be established through the entirety of the Park Farm, This must be kept clear of Traffic and Obstacles at all times.
- Waste: Stall holders are responsible for keeping both the 5 metre area both at the front and back of their space tidy and free of rubbish. Stall holders must leave their site as they found it. All rubbish must be put into the appropriate bins. We ask you all to please take care of the environment.

## Event Access

Please note that on the days (Saturday and Sunday) of Youth Beatz there will be no vehicle access permitted on site, this includes after the event on both days. If you require vehicle access you are able to drop off on site between 10am and 8pm on Friday 29<sup>th</sup> June and anytime from 9am on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2018. There will also be an opportunity to restock on Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> July from 7.30am to 10.30am. We will have 24 hour security on site during these times and the tent where your table will be based will be secured once the event has finished.

On the day, there is no designated car parking, existing Town Centre car parking facilities should be utilised. There will be no vehicle movement onsite on the day of Youth Beatz under any circumstances.
