

# TERMS AND CONDITIONS – YOUTH BEATZ FESTIVAL

## ENTRY INFORMATION

Entry to the festival is by advance ticket only. No tickets will be available on the gates. Please see the ticket section on this website for full details of ticket types and where you can request them.

Young People aged 11 and under must be accompanied by a Ticket holding parent or guardian over the age of 18.

Children aged 2 and under do not require a ticket

## WHAT TIME DO THE GATES OPEN?

Gate opening times:

Saturday 12noon – 10pm & Sunday 12noon – 10pm.

## WHAT IS THE LAST TIME WE CAN ARRIVE BY?

You can arrive until 8pm on Saturday and Sunday, no entry will be permitted after this time.

## CAN WE LEAVE AND COME BACK IN AGAIN?

There will be a pass out system in place between 12noon and 6.30pm, but if you leave after 6.30pm no pass outs will be available

Your possession of this Ticket constitutes your acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.

Upon receipt, please check Tickets carefully as mistakes cannot always be rectified after receipt.

Although Youth Beatz is aimed at young people aged 12-25, we understand that families with younger children will attend the event. As with any music event, certain areas of the site will be extremely busy and it is recommended that these areas are not appropriate for young children, including buggies and pushchairs.

All that children remain the responsibility of their parents & guardians and not the festival.

No duplicate tickets will be issued

Your Ticket may be invalidated if any part of it is removed, altered or defaced.

Where necessary, we reserve the right to make alterations to the published Event or programme. Artists and billed attractions are subject to change.

We reserve the right to refuse you entry to, or eject You from the Event in reasonable circumstances including for health and safety reasons; if you behave in a manner which has or is likely to affect the enjoyment of other persons at the Event; if you use threatening, abusive or insulting words or mannerisms; if you are found in possession of any prohibited item or substance; if in our reasonable opinion You are acting under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

As part of our safety and security plan, the security team undertake general searches of all people entering. This is done for the safety and protection of all. bags are allowed, but only up to A3 size.

We reserve the right to confiscate any item, which in our reasonable opinion may cause danger or disruption to any other persons at the Event or is one of the items not permitted as listed on the Event website. Without limitation, the following may not be brought into the venue: animals (except for assistance dogs); Any recording or transmitting equipment (including professional cameras with lenses of 6 inches or more); pyrotechnics or fireworks; Distress flares & flares; smoke bombs; laser pens; flags on poles; glass containers; items which may be regarded as weapons; illegal substances; legal highs (Inc. nitrous oxide); tables; chairs of any sort, including stools, floor seating and shooting sticks; barbeques and any kind of cooking apparatus; gazebos and parasols; alcohol; large (golf) umbrellas; bicycles, scooters, roller skates; drones.

Anyone attending the event under the influence or in possession of alcohol will be refused entry

Drugs are no more legal at Youth Beatz as they would be any other place, anyone found to be in possession of or under the influence of illegal substances will be refused entry to the event and passed to the Police.

You must comply with all instructions given to you by us, Event staff and stewards.

By attending an Event, you give your express consent to your likeness to be included within any film, photograph, audio and/or audio-visual recording to be used in any media for any purpose at any time. This includes filming by the police or security which may be carried out for the security of customers or the prevention of crime.

You may be prosecuted if you cause damage to the venue, the venue infrastructure, or cause harm to any other person at the Event.

The Event is outdoors and on grass. You are strongly advised to bring appropriate clothing and footwear to protect against potential inclement weather.

Warning – Excessive exposure to loud music may cause damage to your hearing. Please note that pyrotechnics, lasers, smoke machines, strobe lighting or other special effects may take place during some performances.
